THE GAZA CRISIS

Palestine's besieged Gaza strip remains in perpetual crisis. The infrastructure is in ruins, food is scarce, water is contaminated and there is no opportunity to earn. At least half of the two million population is today impoverished.



A joint-blockade has condemned the Muslims of this densely-populated strip to great suffering. Gaza measures just 25 miles long and 4 mile wide. The illegal siege has restricted food, medical supplies, fuel and construction materials to this blessed land; the aim being to squeeze this courageous population into submission.



ISLAMIC CENTRE EDGWARE'S RESPONSE

Brothers and sisters from Islamic Centre Edgware (ICE) came together to **raise £10,500** for the needy communities in Gaza. With the money Ummah Welfare Trust was able to provide warmth and electricity, to poor and displaced students.

PROVIDING NEW SOLAR PANEL SETS

Gaza has been suffering from a chronic deficit of electricity since 2006. The crippling siege means the strip is often without electricity for 20 hours a day. Since the region has around 320 days of sunshine every year, solar panels are an ideal energy solution for schools, hospitals and other services needing to function constantly.

Alhamdulillah, ICE's donation was used to provide two schools in Gaza with new solar panels. The new panels, along with generators, have ensured that hundreds of students can continue to learn under light despite the energy blackouts.
